

Introduction, Old and New Testament Readings on the Battle of Jericho:

Jericho marches are peaceful prayer marches, to reenact the 1400 BC biblical battle of Jericho. When prompted by God, Joshua led the Israelites to march around Jericho, carrying the Ark of the Covenant, for seven days. On the seventh day the walls of Jericho collapsed. This Prayer March is a call for election integrity and a prayer for citizens to vote to uphold Catholic moral values.

“And the second day they marched around the city once, and returned into the camp. So they did for six days. On the seventh day they rose early at the dawn of day, and marched around the city in the same manner **seven times**: it was only on that day that they marched around the city seven times. And at the seventh time, when the priests had blown the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, “Shout; for the LORD has given you the city. “(Joshua 6:14-16, RSVCE)

“**By faith** the walls of Jericho fell down after they had been encircled for seven days. who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, received promises, stopped the mouths of lions, quenched raging fire, escaped the edge of the sword, won strength out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight.” (Hebrews 11:30, 33-34 RSVCE)
